UNIVERSITY CITY HIGH SCHOOL
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Group Renews School Protest in West Phila.

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The West Philadelphia Schools Committee said last night it will continue to oppose construction of a University City Science Center High School in West Philadelphia.

Mrs. Earle Oakes, chairman of the group, said that because the committee did not actively oppose the school at a Board of Education hearing Wednesday night, many thought they had dropped their opposition. She said:

“The West Philadelphia Schools Committee did not specifically oppose a University City Science High School proposal at the public hearing.

“But because of the apparent support the controversial school did receive, we feel obliged to express our emphatic and specific opposition to it,” she added.

The proposed high school, which would specialize in science and mathematics, would be built on a 16-acre tract at 37th st. and Lancaster av.

Mrs. Oakes said the school “like the rest of the board’s capital program which we condemn, perpetuates scattered site building which detracts from the possibility of integration.”

She said the committee believes the school will not advance educational opportunities for Negroes.

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
