In other business the Authority approved the selection of Drexel Institute of Technology as the redeveloper of a 14-acre site in University City Urban Renewal area bounded by Powelton av., 33rd, Ludlow, and 34th sts.

Redevelopment plans include the construction of four dormitories, a day nursery for neighborhood children, a student cafeteria, a physical education center, and a combined garage for 600 cars and graduate research building.

The plans for the \$35.6 million project also call for the relocation of 68 families and 43 businesses as well as the relocating of Lancaster av. between 33rd and 34th sts. one-half block to the north.

The city will contribute \$3.2 million to the project while the federal government will grant \$6.6 million.
