The Redevelopment Authority approved a revised site plan Friday for the West Philadelphia University City High School to permit construction of an experimental school for children of nursery school and kindergarten age.

The \$575,000 experimental school will be built by the University of Pennsylvania on a one-acre lot bounded by Powelton and Lancaster aves., 37th and Warren sts. in the University City urban renewal area. It will be on the northwest corner of the larger high school site.

Will Lease Land

The university will lease the land from the Philadelphia School District, owner of the plot, during construction. It will turn over the completed school to the Board of Education.

The school will operate day-care services and test experimental education programs before they are used in the district at large.

The new facility will replace the Walnut Street Experimental School, now operated by the school district at 3944 Walnut st., to be displaced by university expansion.
